Municipal Solid Waste and Recycling



Municipal solid waste (MSW) includes everything you throw into your trash, including food scraps, yard/lawn clippings, and old appliances. Trash collection for most cities has three bins: black, blue and green.

General guidelines for recycling:

- Recycle all bottles, cans, and paper
- Keep items relatively clean
- Don't mix plastic bags in with the rest of your recycled items

Do Recycle in the Blue Bin:

Plastics 1-7
Paper and Cardboard
Metals
Glass

Don't Recycle in the Blue Bin:

Loose Plastic Bags
Plastics smaller than your palm
Soiled or greasy food boxes/containers
Mylar
Broken or sharp glass
Electronics (e-waste)
Hazardous wast
